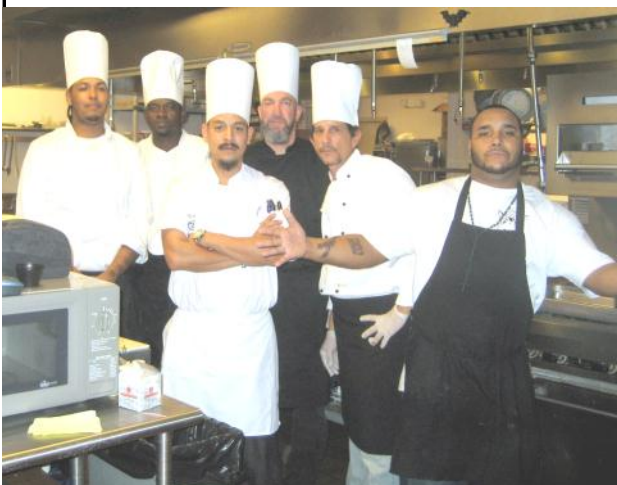
New Golf News
